Six finalists will be chosen to attend and present their posters at EN2020. Finalists will be awarded complimentary student registration at EN2020 and reimbursement of up to \$700 towards flights and accommodation.

The winner will be announced at EN2020 with a **grand prize of \$1,000** towards their research fund, complimentary registration at EN2022 and mentorship opportunities.
